On the occasion of 60th anniversary of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the University of Montenegro, the Parties hereby sign the following

Protocol

on further scientific, technological and business cooperation

within the context of knowledge-based economic and social development in Montenegro in the areas falling within the scope of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the University of Montenegro

The Parties are:

1. **Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the University of Montenegro**, at the address Džordža Vašingtona bb, 81000 Podgorica, as represented by prof. Dr Saša Mujović, the Dean (hereinafter: Faculty),
2. **Central Bank of Montenegro**, at the address Bulevar Sv. Petra Cetinjskog 6, Podgorica, as represented by Mr. Radoje Žugić, the Governor.

Article 1

The Parties hereby sign this Protocol in accordance with the promotion of the third dimension of the university, i.e. in accordance with the:

- Conclusion of the European Commission of 17 May 2021 supporting the European Universities initiative - "Bridging higher education, research, innovation and society: paving the way for a new dimension in European higher education".
- the document of the European Universities "Magna Charta Universitatum 2020" stating that "Universities acknowledge that they have a responsibility to engage with and respond to the aspirations and challenges of the world and to the communities they serve, to benefit humanity and contribute to sustainability."

Article 2

The Parties mutually agree that the economy and society based on knowledge shall develop by relying on the attainment of the fourth industrial revolution that is largely related to the areas falling within the scope of the Faculty.

Article 3

The Parties hereby agree that the Protocol is signed with a view to continuing the bilateral scientific, technological, professional, developmental and business cooperation of mutual benefit.

Article 4

The Parties hereby agree that every concrete cooperation project shall be subject to a separate agreement in the spirit of this Protocol.
