CALL FOR ENTRIES

For awarding prizes to the authors of the best artworks on the theme “25 Years of CBCG”

- I** The Money Museum of the Central Bank of Montenegro, in cooperation with the Secondary School of Fine Arts “Petar Lubarda” in Cetinje, awards prizes for the best artworks on the theme “25 Years of CBCG” on the occasion of celebrating International Museum Day.
- II** The following monetary prizes shall be awarded:
- The first prize 1,000.00 euros,
 - Second prize 800,00 euros,
 - Third prize: 600,00 euros.
- III** Pupils of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th years of the Secondary School of Fine Arts “Petar Lubarda” in Cetinje are eligible to participate in the competition.
- IV** The works must not feature elements of the euro, the USD, or any other valid currencies that constitute legal tender and a lawful payment instrument in any country.
- V** The works shall be submitted to the Money Museum of the Central Bank of Montenegro, Njegoševa Street 122, Cetinje, no later than **24 April 2026**.
- VI** Works submitted after 25 April 2026 shall not be taken into consideration.
- VII** Works may be submitted in the form of drawings, watercolours, oil on canvas, prints, reliefs, digitally designed compositions, or mixed media.
- VIII** The selection of the best works shall be made by a three-member Commission, appointed by a special act of the Governor of the Central Bank of Montenegro. The Commission may decide not to award a prize if it considers that the submitted works have not met the required criteria.
- IX** All prize-winning participants shall be notified in writing of the results of the competition within 10 days of its conclusion.
- X** All submitted works shall become the property of the Money Museum of the Central Bank of Montenegro and will be exhibited in the Money Museum’s lobby on **18 May 2026**.
