

INSTRUCTION ON THE MANNER OF SUBMITTING REPORTS ON POSSIBLE CORRUPTION THREATS TO PUBLIC INTEREST

Pursuant to the Law on Prevention of Corruption (OGM 53/14, 042/17), the Governor of the Central Bank of Montenegro has appointed **Ms. Tatjana Vujanović Vuksanović**, M.Sc, as the designated person (responsible person) to be in charge of receiving and processing reports by whistleblowers. In case of inability to act, her replacement will be **Ms. Mirjana Ivezić**, M.Sc.

The report shall be submitted to the responsible person in writing or as a transcript of a verbal statement, by mail or by electronic means, as follows:

1. in writing and directly in the Central Bank of Montenegro Archives, with the indication of this being a whistleblower report;
2. by mail addressed to the Central Bank of Montenegro, Bul. Svetog Petra Cetinjskog 6, with the indication of the responsible person as the addressee and titled "Whistle-blower report";
3. by e-mail sent to zastita.integriteta@cbcg.me.

As stipulated in the law, the report shall contain a description of the threats to the public interest that indicates the existence of corruption, as well as the signature and personal information of the whistleblower, if he/she does not want to be anonymous, and, if necessary, other facts and circumstances.

Information on the whistleblower's identity, content of the report and supporting documentation will be protected from any unauthorized access and treated as confidential.
